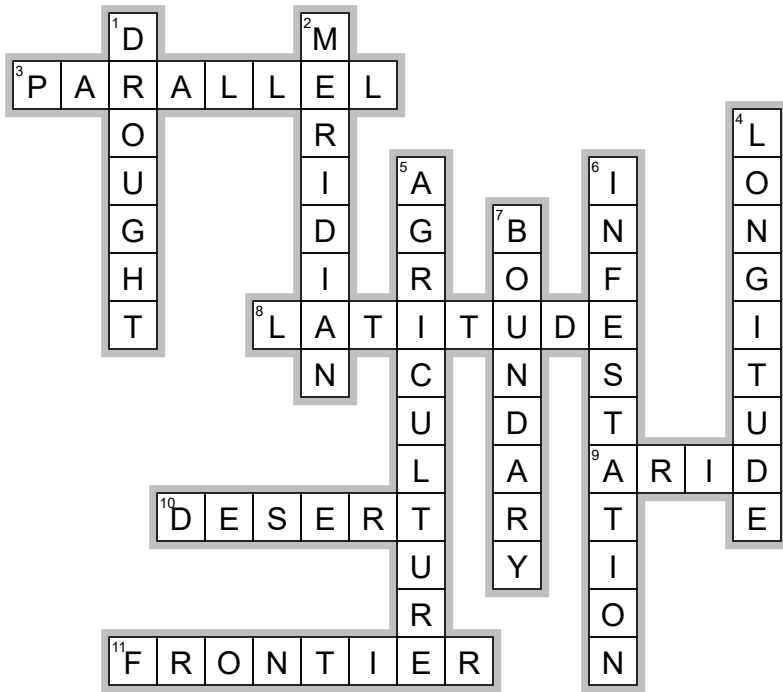


Dakota Pathways: East River, West River

3. PARALLEL — Another name for lines of latitude, which run east and west on the map
8. LATITUDE — Parallel lines starting at the equator measuring distance north and south
9. ARID — Lacking moisture; not enough rain
10. DESERT — Dry, barren, and often sandy region
11. FRONTIER — The extreme limit of settled land beyond which lies wilderness, especially referring to the western US before Pacific settlement

1. DROUGHT — Prolonged period without precipitation
2. MERIDIAN — Another name for lines of longitude, which run north and south on the map
4. LONGITUDE — Meridian lines starting at the Prime Meridian measuring distance east and west
5. AGRICULTURE — Science, art, and business of producing crops and raising livestock
6. INFESTATION — Spread of something harmful
7. BOUNDARY — Something that indicates a border or limit
