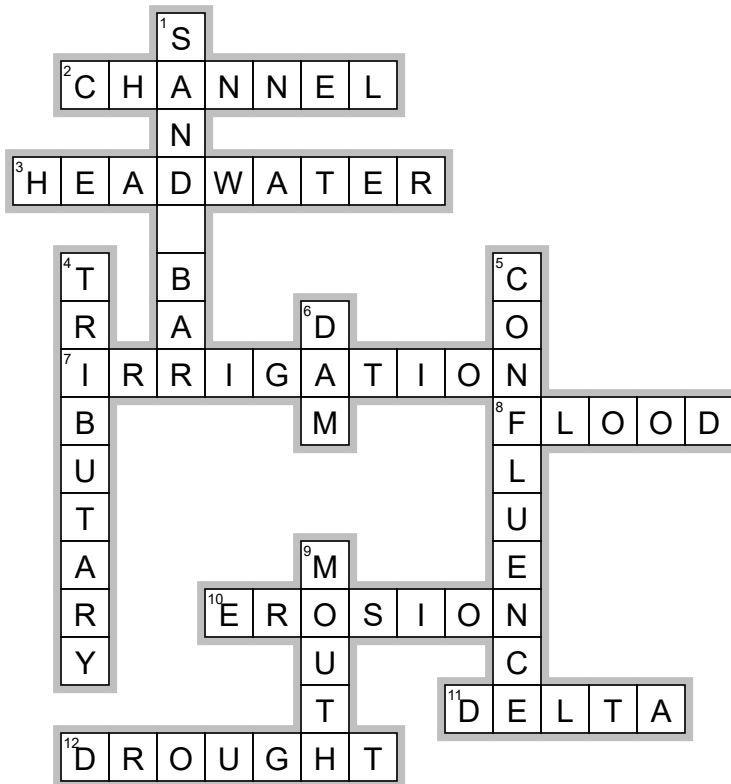


# Dakota Pathways: The Mighty Mo'

2. CHANNEL — Deeper part of a river; usually more navigable

10. EROSION — Process of wearing away
11. DELTA — Fan-shaped area of sediment at mouth of a river
12. DROUGHT — Long period with little or no rainfall

1. SAND BAR — Submerged ridge of sand or gravel
4. TRIBUTARY — Stream or river that feeds into a larger waterway
5. CONFLUENCE — Place where two rivers come together
6. DAM — Structure designed to hold back river water, creating a reservoir
9. MOUTH — End of a river
