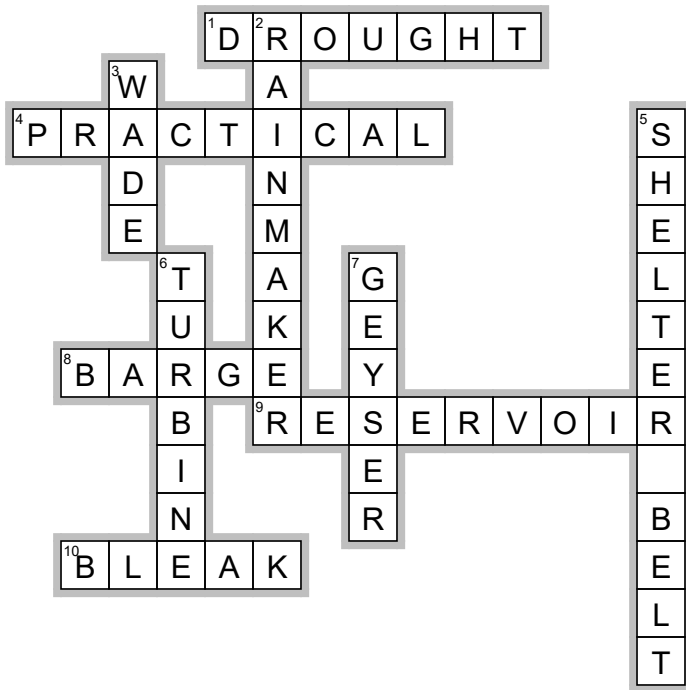


Dakota Pathways: Water and Dust

1. DROUGHT — A period of dryness especially when prolonged that causes extensive damage to crops or prevents their successful growth

2. RAINMAKER — A person who produces or attempts to produce rain by artificial means
3. WADE — To step in or through water
5. SHELTER BELT — A barrier of trees and shrubs that protects (as crops) from wind and storm and lessens erosion
6. TURBINE — A rotary engine rotated by a current of water, usually made with a series of curved vanes on a central rotating spindle
7. GEYSER — A spring that throws forth intermittent jets of heated water and steam
