MontanaPBS will continue with the second installation of their live broadcast special “*Answering Questions About Coronavirus*” on **Thursday, April 2 at 7pm MST**. This program will be available to view on-air, online via montanapbs.org/live and on the MontanaPBS Facebook page.

During this special program, host John Twiggs will hold a conversation via video conference with Dr. Joshua Christensen, Infectious Diseases Specialist at Providence-St. Patrick Hospital; Brent Donnelly, District Director at the U.S. Small Business Administration; and Coralee Schmitz, COO at Rimrock. The panelists will be joined by interview guest, U.S. Senator Jon Tester.
