Teacher & School Submission Tips

Entries:

- Read the rules located at montanapbs.org/writingcontest before beginning.
- Write in your contact information once on the bottom of the entry sheet, then photocopy it to send home for parent signatures.
- We welcome handwritten stories from your students. However, for judging purposes it is helpful to have the story accompanied by a sheet of paper with the typed words. Perhaps you have a parent or classroom volunteer who can do this.
- If a student would like to submit via online submission, a parent/guardian must be present to certify the entry.
- Teachers are welcome to submit one written entry on behalf of an entire class. This will count as one group entry. Teachers may also submit many entries from individual students, but they will require individual entry forms for each student.
- Please limit pages to 8.5 x 11, and keep the content to no more than 4 double-spaced pages.
- We will accept all entries. If you are not able to get parent signatures, do not let this stop you from submitting entries. Unfortunately, only entries with signatures will be eligible to win the competition.
- We will return entries only when specifically requested.
