Only one entry per child • Only single-author stories (no co-authors), however teachers can submit one story on behalf of an entire class (see teacher tips document) • Child must be resident of Montana • Story must be original work of the child • Maximum 1,000 words per entry • Written work can be primarily art-based and can include drawings, paintings, collages, 3-D artwork and photos taken by the author • Story may be fact or fiction, prose or poetry • Hardcopy submissions should use only one side of the paper and each page must be numbered • Text must be printed/written legibly or typed • Children who can't write may dictate their story to be printed or typed • Invented spelling is accepted • Story text may be on pages with illustrations or on separate pages • Non-English text must be translated into English text on the same page, and the translated English text.
