



Lighting Up the NIGHT

Fireflies are small insects that are less than one inch long. They light up because of a chemical reaction that happens inside their bodies, called bioluminescence. Male fireflies use their blinking light to help them find a mate. They will fly around blinking their light in a certain pattern. If a female notices him, she will flash her light back until they reach each other. Not all types of fireflies produce light.
