Position Overview:

Mississippi Public Broadcasting is looking for two part-time distance learning teachers to provide instruction through its Digital Education Network (DEN). These teachers are required to provide instruction Monday through Friday according to the times listed below. Each teacher is assigned three schools per class, two to four times daily. Classes will be taught from the MPB DEN classroom. Certification is required in dual enrollment and in at least one subject matter listed below. This is a contractual position and pay rate will depend on experience and qualification.

Qualification needed:

- Certification in subject matter
- Ability to teach Middle and High School grades
- Available August 2021-May 2022
- Standard Courses and Dual Enrollment for each course, if needed
 - Spanish 1 & 11/certified to teach Dual Enrollment/AP (7:30 a.m. – noon or Noon – 4:00 p.m.)
 - Art I & II/certified to teach Dual Enrollment/AP (8:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m., M-F)
- Strong communication skills. Each school will have a facilitator in the classroom that will assist the distance learning teacher.
- Comfort with using distance learning equipment and technology. We will provide training as needed.
