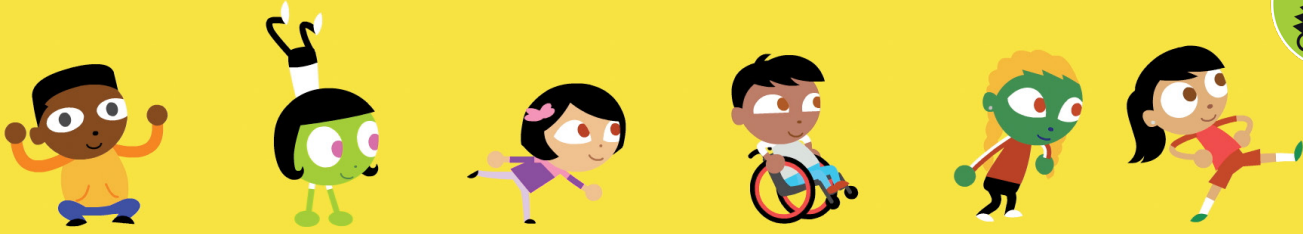


PBS Reno Curiosity Classroom
