Winooski, VT –June 24, 2020— Vermont PBS staff and associates have been honored with three regional Emmy® awards by the Boston/New England Chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences. The awards were presented virtually at the 43rd Emmy® Awards Gala on June 20, 2020, at the [Boston/New England NATAS YouTube channel](#).

Programs from Vermont PBS receiving recognition were [Mister Chris And Friends](#), a live-music series for children age 3-6, which has received a total of seven Emmy nominations since debuting in 2018. In addition, the two-time nominee, [The Future Of Farming Part 1](#), won for Photographer-Program/Non-News. Part of This Land, a collaboration with VPR, it chronicles the serious challenges and potential opportunities for this signature Vermont industry.
