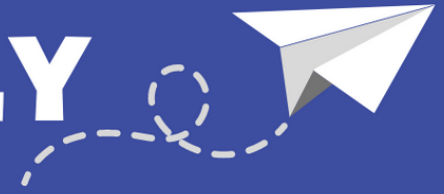




# LESSONS ON THE FLY

**Lesson Title:** Inside Opioid Addiction

**Subject:** PE/Health

**Step 1:** Facilitate class discussion about addiction. Use the “think-pair-share” model to have students share their answers to the following questions:

- Have you been in situations where there were opportunities for drug or alcohol use? Did you feel pressured? Why or why not?
- Why do you think some teens abuse drugs and alcohol? If you asked them, what reasons would they give for using it? What other reasons might they have?
- Imagine that it's 25 years from now and you have a teenage son or daughter exactly the same age as you are now. What would you say to him or her about drinking and drugs?
- Name two things you would like to accomplish by the time you graduate high school. How could drugs and alcohol use get in the way of those goals?

**Step 2:** Share the interactive, self-paced lesson with students, with a reminder to read/watch all media and answer each question thoroughly. (Students will need to either create a free PBS Learning Media account or record their answers on paper.)

## Materials:

1. Computers or ipads
2. Note-taking supplies (paper or computer)

**Step 3:** After students have finished, you may want to have them discuss both what they have learned and the self-paced process they used. Potential questions include:

- What did you learn?
- What was surprising?
- What questions do you still have?
- What was easiest for you to understand and do? What was most difficult?
- Which parts of the lesson did you find most useful in helping you understand the topic?
