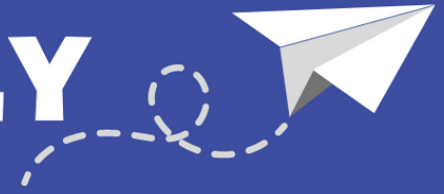

Lesson Title: Latino Americans Share Their Experiences

Subject: Social Studies

Grade: 9-10

Step 1: Facilitate class discussion about identity. Use the “think-pair-share” model to have students share their answers to the following questions:

- What parts of your identity do you choose for yourself & what parts are determined for you by other people or by society?

Step 2: Share the interactive, self-paced lesson with students, with a reminder to read/watch all media and answer each question thoroughly. (Students will need to either create a free PBS Learning Media account or record their answers on paper.)

Step 3: Facilitate class discussion about what they have learned. Potential questions include:

- What did you learn?
- What was surprising?
- What questions do you still have?
- Which parts of the lesson did you find most useful in helping you understand the topic?
