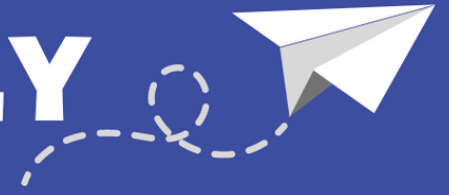

Lesson Title: Who, Me? Biased? Understanding Implicit Bias

Subject: English

Grade: 9-10

Step 1: Facilitate class discussion about bias. Use the following questions:

- What is bias?
- What is the difference between implicit and explicit?
- What is a stereotype?

Step 2: Share the interactive, self-paced lesson with students, with a reminder to read/watch all media and answer each question thoroughly. (Students will need to either create a free PBS Learning Media account or record their answers on paper.)

Step 3: Facilitate class discussion about their learning. Use the following questions:

- What was surprising?
- What questions do you still have?
- What was easiest for you to understand and do? What was most difficult?
