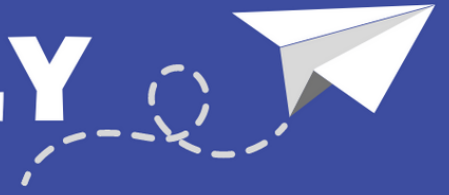

Lesson Title: Working Together

Step 1: Introduce new words: reduce, reuse, recycle. Wonder: How do leaves and leftover food scraps turn into new soil?

Step 2: Review the Science Notebook page to understand what information to collect from the video. Get ready to read the story with a purpose.

Step 3: Watch video clips or read the 'Let's Explore' section of the storybook. Record what you learn about the compost cycle in your Science Notebook.

Step 4: Talk: How does food waste turn into new soil?
