

# “Anguish”

I came across your website by clicking on a picture of my Uncle, Sgt. Kenny who was killed within the first couple weeks of TET. He was killed North of Lai Khe which itself is north of Saigon.

On your website there is that mural of all the words, the one I seen my uncles pic on was "Anguish". You see my mother (Kennys little sister Debbie) is from Schenectady, NY and on that picture of my Uncle under "Anguish" there is my uncles pic, but in the corner of that pic there is a man in a yellow shirt talking to 3 NY State Troopers. The man MUST have known my uncle, because in a smaller caption pic in the bottom corner, there is someone holding up a bracelet with my uncles name on it when he was killed.

My reason for reaching out to you today is can you PLEASE tell me who that man is, or put him in contact with me. I can feel he knew my uncle Kenny, the evidence is clear, it looks like he was telling those troopers what happened that day.

I am the son of a Marine Vietnam Vet who served up in the North near the DMZ, he came back home in 1970 after 2 tours. All my life I have been told about my uncle. I tried several times to try and find the story associated with the pic I found on your website, but was unsuccessful.
