Health	Regional Voices	2/24/19	10:00am	30 minutes	This episode of Regional Voices featured local medical experts discussing new advances in diagnosing Breast Cancer.
Legislation	Lawmakers 2019	1/18/19-3/31/19	Fridays 10pm and Sundays 11:30am	30 minutes	This weekly series featured local legislators and they discussed the news of the week from the Indiana Statehouse.
Education	EVSC Community Link	2/16/19	5:00pm	30 minutes	This monthly program highlights local non-profits and is produced by the students of Bosse High School.
Senior Abuse	Senior Fraud: Financial Safety for Seniors	1/17/19	7:00pm	60 minutes	This local production featured local and State experts in the issue of financial fraud, focusing on senior citizens. Viewers learned about the various types of scams, how to handle them, and where to get help.
Military	Regional Voices	3/22/19	10:00am	30 minutes	This episode of Regional Voices featured Colonel Garlington from the Crane Naval Base in Indiana discussing the importance of ammunition storage for war-time efforts and the impact on the local economy.
War History	Chester & Gertrude At War	3/28/19	7:00pm	60 minutes	This local production highlighted the life of one local gentleman's trip overseas to serve in WWI. Chester's relatives traveled to France with WNIN's crew to see where Chester was killed in service and to see his name added to a local war monument.
History	Evansville Remembers the Vietnam War	3/24/19	11:30am	30 minutes	This special featured local Vietnam Vets as they told their war-time stories including how the war affected them, the world, and the Evansville area.
History	Picture This African American History and Breweries	1/6/19	10:00AM	30 minutes	This local studio program featured archival photographs highlighting Evansville's African American History and the history of breweries in Evansville. A panel of local experts discussed each photograph and its significance to local history.
History	Tri-State Life 101	2/3/19	8:30am	30 minutes	This local magazine program looked at several local "characters" that have interesting hobbies ranging from building birdhouses to making yarn from sheep.
