Business	JA Hall of Fame	4/20/19 4/21/19	4:30pm 8:30am	90 minutes	This program featured the inductees into the 2019 Junior Achievement Hall of Fame including a synopsis of their lives, their contributions, and the awards ceremony.
Legislation	Lawmakers 2019	4/2/19-4/21/19	Fridays 10pm and Sundays 11:30am	30 minutes	This weekly series featured local legislators and they discussed the news of the week from the Indiana Statehouse.
History	LST-325 History on the Riverfront	6/5/19	1:00pm	30 minutes	This local production provided the viewer with a walking tour of the LST-325 Museum ship based at Evansville's Riverfront.
Senior Abuse	Senior Fraud: Financial Safety for Seniors	4/24/19	12:30pm	60 minutes	This local production featured local and State experts in the issue of financial fraud, focusing on senior citizens. Viewers learned about the various types of scams, how to handle them, and where to get help.
