Issue	Program	Date	Time	Duration	Type/Description
Air Pollution/Health	Healthy Air: Healthy Communities 121	10/23/14	7:00pm	30 minutes	This episode looked at the changes and updates that have occurred with local greenways and trails. It also included tips on using the trails and highlighted Vanderburgh and Warrick counties.
Politics	Regional Voices	11/2/14	10:00pm	30 minutes	This program featured the local Vanderburgh County Sheriff candidates as they addressed the local Rotary Club.
Air Pollution/Health	Healthy Air: Healthy Communities 122	11/20/14	7:00pm	30 minutes	This episode focused on how our local air quality has improved over the past two years and why. It also looked at how this improvement can affect the health of our community. It ended with encouraging tips for continued progress.
Culture	Sounds of the Season	11/27/14	7:00pm	60 minutes	Sounds of the Season featured local high school choirs as they sang both traditional and contemporary holiday songs.
Air Pollution/Health	Healthy Air: Healthy Communities 123	12/18/14	7:00pm	30 minutes	The last episode of this series featured the experts that make up the Healthy Air Group as they discussed their favorite stories and the impact each had on them. They also discussed the importance of keeping our air quality in the minds of our community.
History	WNIN's Top 9 101 Weather Disasters	10/18/14	6:30pm	30 minutes	This episode looked at the history of major weather disasters in the Tri-State area including major floods, recent and past tornadoes, and winter storms. Local meteorologists and witnesses described the worst weather events in the Tri-State's history.
History	WNIN's Top 9 105 Historic Buildings in Evansville	10/11/14	6:30pm	30 minutes	This episode looked at the top 9 most interesting historic structures in Evansville and their significance on the city's history
History/Education	Regional Voices	10/26/14	10:00pm	30 minutes	This program featured Greg Hager, the new director of Willard Library. Hager discussed the expansion of the library, it's extensive collection of geneology materials, and historical photos.
