Issue	Program	Date	Time	Duration	Type/Description
Employment	Career Pathways: Taking the Technical Path	4/2/17 4/13/17	11:00am 7:00pm	30 minutes	This locally-produced special focused on the advantages and benefits of taking a technical path in middle/high school as opposed to a path into a 4-year degrees. Statistics show that jobs in manufacturing are opening up and providing rewarding careers with good benefits.
Legislative Activity	Lawmakers 2017	Sundays at 11:30am	4/2/17 – 4/9/17	30 minutes	This half-hour interview/discussion featured local State Representatives and Senators discussing the week's progress in the Indiana State House.
The American Dream	Old Dreams, New Ideas	4/13/17	7:30pm	30 minutes	This special featured local experts and a variety of man-on-the-street interviews in a look at whether the American Dream is still alive and what is included in that Dream. A conclusion is reached that the American Dream continues include a home, family, and security, but is much harder to achieve.
Community	Live Local in Warrick County	5/25/17	7:30pm	30 minutes	This program featured the activities that make up agri-business and events in Warrick County. Highlights included various Farmers' markets, wineries, farms, etc.
Driving Safety	Life in the Safe Lane	6/1/17	7:30pm	30 minutes	Driving safety was the focus of this program, educating viewers on activities and conditions that can lead to accidents. The program also included instructions for handling traffics incidents and accidents.
Local Culture	Sunset at Semper Fulgens	6/22/17	8:00pm	60 minutes	This program highlighted a local concert featuring Matthew O'Neill and Darrell Scott. The program was performed and recorded at an downtown Evansville residence known as Semper Fulgens.
History	WNIN's Top 9	4/23/17	10:30am	30 minutes	This local episode focused on Evansville's historic buildings between the 30's and 60's.
History	The Field That Bosse Built	4/20/17	7:00pm	60 minutes	This documentary told the story of local baseball field, Bosse Field. The second oldest ball park in the nation, the program featured testimonials from many local residents and enthusiasts including field owner.
