| History | Holiday World: The Koch's Recipe for Success | 10/19/17 | 7:00pm | 60 minutes | This documentary focuses on the lives of Bill and Pat Koch, founders of the Holiday World theme park located in Santa Claus Land, Indiana. |
| Culture/Travel | Tri-State Life | 10/8/17 | 3:30pm | 30 minutes | This local program featured local artisans and their crafts. From a yarn weaver, to a birdhouse creator, viewers get a taste of the local flavor that our region presents |
| History | From The Ashes | 12/13/17 | 8:00pm | 60 minutes | This local documentary focused on the 1977 plane crash that killed the UE Basketball Team. Interviews with those who remember the evening, reported the news, and lost loved ones. |
| Community | Live Local in Warrick County | 10/26/17 | 7:00pm | 30 minutes | This program featured the activities that make up agri-business and events in Warrick County. Highlights included various Farmers' markets, wineries, farms, etc. |
| History | Evansville At War | 11/9/17 11/16/17 | 7:00pm | 60 minutes | Evansville's great history during WWII is the focus of this local documentary. The Shipyard that create the LSTs to the manufacturing of bullets, Evansville was instrumental to the war effort as the war was to Evansville. |
| Travel | Harlaxton: Secret Places | 11/20/17 | 8:30pm | 30 minutes | This documentary took the viewer on a tour of the University of Evansville's Harlaxton Manor, located in England. |
| Community | New Vision New Harmony | 10/12/17 | 7:00pm | 60 minutes | This local documentary looked the utopian community of New Harmony Indiana. After a brief history, viewers learned about the many attractions and events. |
| Community | Old Dreams New Ideas | 11/5/17 | 6:30pm | 30 minutes | This locally produced program examined the lifestyles of the Evansville area and asked the question is the American Dream still alive during the recent state of economy in the US. Locally, citizens stated they still believe in the traditional American Dream. |
