Issue	Program	Date	Time	Duration	Type/Description
History	Evansville At War 101	7/2/18	11:00pm	60 minutes	Part 1 of this documentary highlights the Evansville area during World War II. Interviews highlight the production of the ships, planes, and ammunition that spurred local employment.
History	Evansville At War 102	7/9/18	11:00pm	60 minutes	Part 2 of this documentary highlights interviews and stories of individuals that were directly involved with WWII in both Evansville and oversea.
History	The Field That Bosse Built	7/12/18	7:00pm	60 minutes	This program investigates the history of one of Evansville's signature landmarks, the third oldest ballpark in the US behind Fenway Park and Wrigley Field, and the noted location of many scenes from the 1992 Hollywood classic "A League of Their Own".
History	WNIN's Top 9 "Weather Disasters"	9/27/18	7:00pm	30 minutes	This program chronicled the history of famous weather disasters in the Tri-State area including floods, tornadoes, and winter storm.
History	Two Elephants	7/8/18	2:00pm	60 minutes	This locally-produced documentary looked at the history of Elephants at the Evansville Zoo. The story started with Kay the Elephant and the impact she had on the community and ended with a look at Bunny the Elephants life at the zoo and her tragic death.
Community	Regional Voices "Habitat For Humanity"	7/15/18	10:00am	30 minutes	Executive Director of Habitat for Humanity, Beth Folz, presented in from of the Evansville chapter of Rotary providing information about the efforts and progress of the local Habitat for Humanity.
Community	Regional Voices "Evansville Vanderburgh Public Library"	8/5/18	10:00am	30 minutes	Executive Director of the Evansville Vanderburgh Public Library System, Cynthia Landrum, talked with the Evansville chapter of Rotary and described the valuable service the library provides to the public and listed the many services available.
Community	New Vision New Harmony	9/13/18	7:00pm	60 minutes	This local documentary looked the utopian community of New Harmony Indiana. After a brief history, viewers learned about the many attractions and events.
Community	Tri-State Life	7/5/18	7:00pm	60 minutes	These back to back episodes provided a look into the many interesting people in the Tri-State and the interesting hobbies they have.
