Local Transportation	In Harmony's Way: The Battle to Save a Bridge	10/20/16	4:00pm	60 minutes	This documentary highlighted New Harmony Bridge that linked New Harmony, Indiana with Illinois and was the road that many traveled to get to work and shop. The bridge was recently closed due to structural problems and local citizens were lobbying the State to pay for repairs
State Legislation	Indiana Week in Review	Mondays at 5pm, Tuesdays at 4:30pm, Thursdays at 5pm and Fridays at 4pm		30 minutes	This weekly program features a look at the issues facing Indiana citizens. Each issue is debated between a variety of guests with different backgrounds and viewpoints.
Black History	Indiana Trailblazers	Wednesdays 11/9-11/23	5:00pm	60 minutes	This 3-part series traces the steps of African-Americans as they migrate from the southern slave states and organize prosperous black settlements and thriving commerce centers across Indiana.
Legal Issues	Indiana Courts	Sundays at 5pm, Tuesdays at 6pm, and Saturdays at 4pm		60 minutes	This series consists of various Indiana Supreme Court appeals that have occurred over the past several years. These trials portray a variety of cases and crimes and allow viewers to hear the arguments and rulings.
Drug Abuse	Addressing the Heroin Epidemic	11/22/16	5:30pm	30 minutes	A new piece of legislation is aimed at curbing the nation's opioid epidemic. CARA or the Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act increases drug prevention and education efforts and promotes treatment and recovery. It's the first major federal addiction legislation in four decades. What it means for states and local communities that are battling opioid abuse.
History	Celebrate Indiana: The Bicentennial Gala	12/12/16	6:00pm	60 minutes	Hoosiers from across the State will celebrate Indiana's Bicentennial with a look at the state's past, present, and future. Special guests, performances by Hoosiers, and a celebration of the heritage that makes up the 92 counties in the State of Indiana.
History	Hoosiers: The Story of Indiana	10/10/16-10/31/16	6:00pm	60 minutes	A four-hour documentary series based upon the definitive history of Indiana by James Madison called "Hoosiers: A New History of Indiana". The programs add a dimension to the state's history by exploring it through the descendants of ordinary Hoosiers who lived through extraordinary times, and who helped to shape the fabric of our state.
