**Journey of the Whooping Crane**

At five feet tall, with a wingspan over seven feet, the Whooping Crane has the distinction of being North America's tallest bird and also one of its rarest. Habitat loss and hunting pressure reduced the population to just 15 birds by 1940. An intense effort to protect and restore them has the current population at 600.

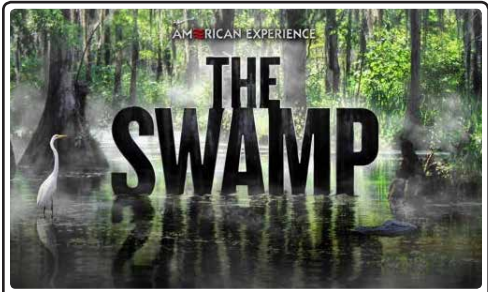

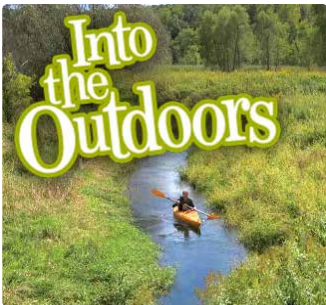
