WVIA Radio Highlights

Elektra, Saturday at 1pm

Shortly after conquering the opera world with his scandalous masterpiece Salome, Richard Strauss turned to Hugo von Hofmannsthal's recent adaptation of Sophocles's Elektra for his next project. The resulting opera is an intense and still-startling work that unites the commanding impact of Greek tragedy with the unsettling insights of early-20th-century Freudian psychology. The drama unfolds in a single act of rare vocal and orchestral power.

This archival performance from the Swedish Royal Opera features the legendary Birgit Nilsson in the vocally challenging title role. Charbro Ericson sings the role of Elektra's mother Clytemnestra. The comparatively lyrical Chrysothemis is sung by Berit Lindholm. Rounding out this very dysfunctional family is the brother Orestes, portrayed in this production by Erik Saedén.

Tensions in Berlin, Sunday at 2pm

Coming together in a "ghost concert": the magical sound of Sharon Kam's clarinet; violinist Christian Tetzlaff and a piece he's been working on for forty years and still finds astonishing; violinist Antje Haas and Beethoven's crisis management. They're all friends of Lars – Lars Vogt, director of "Tensions." Chamber music at its finest, by Janacek, Bartok, Beethoven and Brahms.

"Ghost concerts" is what they've called audience-free events in Germany during the pandemic.
